

**HARRISBURG IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE  
ADMINISTRATIVE RESOLUTION POLICY RESOLUTION #7**

WHEREAS Article VI, Section 2, C, 10 of the CC&R's (page 8) states the following:: The Board shall be the sole judge as to the final appropriate maintenance of the Common Areas. Article VI section 1, H of the CC&R's (page 6) states the following: No owners shall remove, alter, injure, or interfere in any way with any landscaping, shrubs, trees, grass or planting placed upon any of the common areas, without prior written approval from the Board.

The Board of Directors shall appoint a Harrisburg Improvement Committee, to include a Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, and Treasurer, and as many volunteers as needed for the improvement and maintenance of the Memorial Park development plan and to all common areas that will add to the recreation and enjoyment of said owners.

Goal - To provide a natural interpretive botanical area that will be attractive and provide an educational opportunity to residents as well as provide food and shelter for birds and small wildlife and to improve the amenities and beautify our property for the enjoyment of all.


1. Maintain walking path loop around edge of park, edge the path with rocks and cover it with wood chips. Install drain pipes as necessary at moist areas.
2. Install and maintain drip system to existing memorial trees in bottom areas.
3. Plant and maintain drought resistant plants throughout bottom and sides above the trail where residents have not previously planted. All future planting by residents below their property lines must be approved by the Harrisburg Improvement Committee and meet these requirements.
4. Limit future planting of trees to approval of HIC and ACC.
5. Remove Salt Cedar (Tamarisk), Russian thistle and Cottonwood Trees. This is an invasive non-native plant that crowds everything else out.
6. No weed cutting will be allowed within eight feet (8 ft.) from the stream channel.
7. Seal and maintain the bridges over the creek.
