



The Ancient History of Quail Lake

When you are leaving Harrisburg and driving on 318 around Quail Lake, look to your right at the multicolored rock layers that line the road. The brownish-gray rock sediments you will see out the passenger window and across from the campground were laid down during the Triassic period (252 to 201 million years ago).


The sediments consist of mudstone, limestone, shale, and gypsum and were deposited here from meandering streams flowing from the ocean. The ocean, referred to as the Panthalassic Ocean, could be seen from where you are driving because this area was at sea level and neither California nor Nevada existed!

As you look up at the red, gold, and purple rock layers, each layer represents a more recent period of geologic time with the youngest layers being on the top. This rocky area is referred to as the Moenkopi Formation. Moenkopi is a Hopi word for "place of running water."

The climate was subtropical and the creatures living in it were marine mollusks, brachiopods, ammonoids and fish. Early lizards and dinosaurs began to appear, but the dinosaurs were the size of kangaroos! This was also the time of Pangea when all the continents were connected into one massive continent.

The same processes that created this colorful area also created Capitol Reef, Canyonlands, San Rafael Swell, and Monument Valley. Future volcanic eruptions and plate tectonic movements uplifted the area over millions of years to give us this beautiful setting.



Viral TikTok Cucumber Salad

Ingredients

- 1 Cucumber, sliced
- 1.5 Tbsp Soy sauce
- 1 Tbsp Sesame oil
- 1 tsp Fish sauce
- 1 tsp Sugar
- sprinkle MSG (Accent)
- 1 clove garlic **grated**
- 2 green onions **sliced**
- 1 tbsp toasted sesame seeds
- Chili Oil to taste


Instructions

- 1. Use a mandolin to directly slice the cucumber into a deli quart container. Alternatively, use a knife to thinly slice a cucumber and place it in a bowl.
- 2. Add the rest of the ingredients to the container (or bowl).
- 3. Place the lid on the container and shake until the cucumber slices are coated evenly with all the ingredients. If your cucumbers are in a bowl, toss well.
- 4. Enjoy immediately, or place in the fridge and marinate for a couple of hours then enjoy. The cucumbers will be crunchier the faster you eat the salad, so if you want a fresh cucumber salad, enjoy immediately. If you want more of a quick pickled cucumber salad, let marinate for 1-2 hours before enjoying.
- 5. This is one of those recipes where you can add things or leave things out. The original recipe I found called for soy sauce, sesame oil, rice wine vinegar, chili oil, sesame seeds, and MSG, and they didn't even measure anything, just a few shakes of this and a dash of that. Have fun with it!
